



GETTING THERE

By Road
From the M4

- Leave the M4 at junction 19 (signed Bristol & M32)
- Join the M32 into Bristol. At the end of the M32 (Newfoundland Street A4032), turn left at the traffic lights (signed Temple Meads Station, A4 & Bath) onto Bond Street.
- Go past Temple Meads Station on your left and continue to a large roundabout.
- Go all the way round the roundabout, doubling back so that Temple Meads Station is now on your right.
- Stay in the left hand lane and bear left into Redcliffe Way.
- The hotel is located on the left hand side.

From Bath

- Leave Bath via the A4 (Bristol Road)
- Pass Temple Meads railway station on the right.
- At the large roundabout, bear left into Redcliffe Way.
- The hotel is located on the left hand side.

By Train

- Bristol Temple Meads is nearest station, which is ¼ mile from our hotel.
