DISCRETIONS UNDER THE NEW LGPS REGULATIONS

The Town Council has now formulated its policies relating to the above discretions. They have been determined as follows:

- A. The Council should waive an employee's pension contributions when he/she has achieved 40 years local government membership of the local government pension scheme and is unable to accrue additional pensionable service, however should the employee continue in employment beyond the age of 60, contributions would be reinstated where further service could be accrued to a maximum of 45 years at age 65.
- B, C, D, E. The Council notes the new discretion but has no intention to make general use of this discretionary power but may wish to consider its use in exceptional cases in the future.

The Council will keep these policies under review and I will inform you of any alterations.
